ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Director General, Highways Department has informed that, due to promotions in the post of Chief Engineer and retirement on superannuation, 8 vacancies have now arisen in the cadre of Superintending Engineer. The proposal for granting temporary promotion under Section 47(1) of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 to the 10 eligible Divisional Engineers in the order of their seniority, for posting against the places noted against their names, is sent for approval of Government and the proposed promotion as Superintending Engineers may be regulated in the regular panel of Divisional Engineers fit for promotion as Superintending Engineer for the year 2026-2027.

2. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Director General, Highways Department and hereby order that the following eligible Divisional Engineers are promoted as Superintending Engineers on temporary basis under Section 47(1) of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 and posted to the stations as given below:-

3. Further, there is no charge / punishment / conviction pending against the above Divisional Engineers at present. It is certified that the 10 Divisional Engineers on promotion to the post of Superintending Engineers will be entitled to be paid in that post from date of joining and they have fulfilled the qualification for holding the post of Superintending Engineers as per Government Letter No.8199/FR.II/1980, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department, dated 30.04.1980.

4. Also the temporary promotion ordered in para 2 above is subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The individuals who have been temporarily promoted as Superintending Engineers under section 47(1) of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 shall be filled up in future by bringing in individuals who are eligible for promotion. As soon as possible.
- (ii) The above individuals who have been temporarily promoted shall not be eligible to claim any preference for higher posts in future by virtue of the promotions.
- (iii) The post of Superintending Engineering shall be liable to the dismissed by the appointing authority at any time without notice and without assigning any reason what so ever under section 47(5) of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016.
